

Wall Covering Cleaning Instructions

To obtain maximum service from your wall coverings please note the following care instructions.



Cleaning

- Remove any stains as quickly as possible. If certain materials remain too long, it may cause permanent discoloration.
- We recommend that you do not spray wall covering with a protective coating, such as wax. This can cause discoloration.
- Begin cleaning at the bottom of the wall covering and work up, always wiping with the seams, usually up and down.
- Always use clean, soft materials to wash and dry your wall covering. The best method is to use warm water and a mild detergent. A sponge is recommended for washing, followed by a clean, lint-free cloth to dry.
- Try cleaning materials in an inconspicuous location before cleaning entire wall.
- Use of abrasive cleaners such as steel wool or powdered cleaners is not recommended.
- Use of active solvent-type cleaning preparations, such as nail polish remover, tar and bug removers, etc., because they will remove print and/or finish from the wall covering and will reduce or eliminate permeability of perforated wall covering is not recommended.
- For wall coverings that are delicate or not washable, we recommend using a dry cleaning eraser or dry cleaning sponge.
